

What You Can Do

- Protest the Saudi-U.S. attack on Yemen
 - Hold a rally with signs, banners and chants . Show some of the damage and victims.
 - Invite other groups. Send out notices to the media and the politicians.
 - Write a small sign, take a selfie and tweet the picture
- Let the media and members of Congress know about Senator Chris Murphy's call to suspend arms sales to Saudi Arabia
 - Read up on what Murphy has said and watch video of his Senate speech at www.SaudiUS.org
 - Make your version of the PEP press release and send it to the media.

 - Talk to your members of Congress or their aides and ask legislation to be drawn up to suspend the arms sales
- Take part in campaigns to free political prisoners in Saudi dungeons. Check out material from Amnesty International and work with their local activists
- Join with other activists around Palestine, drones, climate, etc. Support their actions and talk to them about Saudi regime crimes.
- Find out where Saudi regime money is being spread in your area: colleges, foundations, politicians and bring this to public attention with flyers and picketing
- Learn about what the Saudis have done to Bahrain and join in efforts to release political prisoners **www.bahrainrights.org/** and to get the U.S. Fifth Fleet out of Bahrain
- Have your group join our **Coalition to End the U.S.-Saudi Alliance**
- Write letters and op-eds to newspapers
- Follow @YemenPostNews and save copies of photos and print them out. Print out the cartoons and drawings of Carlos Latuff and Gianluca Costantini
