28/20 Traffic Calming - Stourbridge Rd. Fairfield

The Committee recommended that Worcester County Council are contracted to provide an area of hardstanding on County council land on Stourbridge Road Fairfield for use by the Safer Roads Partnership for locating their speed camera vehicles. The cost advised by the County Council is £2,500.

County Cllr. Shirley Webb has indicated that she should be able to provide some financial support from her Divisional fund 2020/21.

29/20 County Cllr. May Divisional Fund

The Committee noted outstanding funds were held for improvements in Belbroughton ward and it will aim to have pledged these against specific items of expenditure before the end of the financial year. Possible uses were contributions to the Little Bell Hall Pool survey and if agreed as a project to a CCTV installation.

30/20 Maintenance Work

Cllr. Hood advised that a County Council light on the A491 adjacent to the Indian restaurant was unlit and that the 'keep left' bollards and directional signs in the area required cleaning. **Action:** the clerk would report to the W.C.C. Hub.

Cllr. Mabbett advised of a large pothole on Brook Road, Fairfield. Cllr. Ingram advised of a large pothole on Hartle Lane, Belbroughton. **Action:** the clerk would report to the W.C.C. Hub.

31/20 Any other Finance Business

The Committee noted that the District Council had advised in an e mail to the clerk that it would wish to commence charging the Parish Council from April 2020 for emptying of litter bins and that this charge in future should be passed onto residents. The bins involved had been purchased many years ago by the Parish Council to assist the District Council with its obligation to keep the area litter free.

The clerk had requested details of the figures involved and the Committee would recommend a response to the District Council when these were known.

However, it noted that the Parish Council's budget for 2020/21 had already been approved prior to receipt of the e mail from the District Council.
