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Notice of a Public Meeting being held to consider an application for a proposed Land Severance (Application Number B03-2019)

Please take notice that the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Neebing, sitting as Committee of the Whole, will hold a Public Meeting on Wednesday, September 4th, 2019, at 5:00 p.m., at the Neebing Municipal office to consider a proposed severance under Section 53 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended. The Committee's recommendations to Council will be considered for ratification at the Regular Council Meeting on the same evening, commencing at 6:00 p.m.

The Application (B03-2019) is brought by Rudy Stajkowski, the property owner. The land parcel which is the subject matter of the application has municipal address 1697 Pardee Road. The legal description of the land is: Part of the Southeast Quarter Section of Lot 8, Concession 3, excluding Parts 1 through 4, inclusive, on Reference Plan of Survey 55R-13526, within geographic Pardee Township, Municipality of Neebing, in the District of Thunder Bay. This is referred to as the "Subject Property".

The proposed severance would result in one new lot, and the retained lot. A sketch showing the lot configuration is included with the application, a copy of which is enclosed. The retained lot will have frontage of approximately 500 meters on Pardee Road at the south, and approximately 592 meters on Pardee Road at the east, and the severed lot will have frontage of approximately 212 meters on Pardee Road. The severed lot will contain the existing dwelling on the property, and the retained lot will be vacant, apart from a barn. The severed lot will be rectangular in shape, with a depth (from Pardee Road) of approximately 94 meters, and an area of approximately 2 hectares (5 acres), The retained lot will be irregular in shape, with varying depths, and an area of approximately 58 hectares (143 acres) in area. All measurements are "approximate", and will be finalized when the required survey has been completed.

ANY PERSON may attend the Public Meeting and/or make written or verbal presentations either in support of, or in opposition to, the proposed land severance.

Written submissions to the Council can be forwarded to the Solicitor-Clerk at the address on this letterhead or by email to clerk@neebing.org. Submissions by regular letter-mail, facsimile, electronic mail or personal delivery are accepted, however, the onus is on the person submitting the information (by whatever means) to make sure that it was actually received in time for consideration by Council prior to Council's final decision on the matter.

If a person or public body would otherwise have an ability to appeal the decision of the Council of the municipality of Neebing to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal, but the person or public body does not make oral submissions at the public meeting, or make written submissions to the Municipality of Neebing before the recommendations relating to the severance application are adopted, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at the public meeting, or make written submissions to the Municipality of Neebing before the recommendations of the Committee relating to the severance application are approved by Council, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.

If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Council on the proposed severance, you must make a written request to the Solicitor-Clerk for the Municipality, at the address shown on this Notice. Written requests may be sent using the contact information shown on the letterhead of this notice.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION related to the proposed severance is available for inspection between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. at the Neebing Municipal Office.
