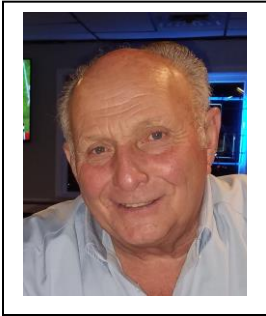

Extension of Prohibition on Sale of Alcohol by Certain Permittees Without the Sale of Food. The provisions of Executive Order No. 7D, Section 2 not previously repealed, and as amended by Executive Order Nos. 7G, 7T, and 7ZZ, which prohibit the sale of alcohol by certain permittees without the sale of food, shall remain in effect until February 9, 2021, unless earlier modified or terminated.
