Prepare for Some Movies about Faith

Lent is a preparation for Easter. Lent is a time of repentance, fasting, and confession. Lent is 40 days of preparing our hearts and minds for the joy and glory of Easter. I pray that Lent is a fruitful time for all of you. That being stated, I also want to prepare you for several faith-based movies that will be coming out before Easter. Please note that movie release release dates can change sometimes.

<u>Samson-</u> This movie was released last Friday. It is from a good movie company called Pure Flix and this company has made a lot of good faith-based movies. Samson received great strength from God to defeat the evil Philistines and you should see Delilah in this film as well. I will be going to see this movie on Monday (19th) at the Cinemark in Mansfield at the 11 a.m. show time. Feel free to join me if you are able.

<u>I Can Only Imagine-</u> This move is set to be released on March 16. It tells the story of what inspired a member of the Christian band Mercy Me to write the song -"I Can Only Imagine" - that has become a classic in the Christian music industry. A big part of the movie is the conversion of his dad.

<u>Paul- Apostle of Christ-</u> This movie is set to be released on March 28. This movie is the one I am most excited to see. It has James Faulkner as Paul and Jim Caviezel as Luke. Caviezel portrayed Jesus in "The Passion of the Christ." The preview I saw has Luke trying to convince Paul to give him his letters, so they can be preserved. Luke wrote a Gospel and the Acts of the Apostles. The Acts include many stories about Paul as well as the Apostles.

God's Not Dead: A Light in Darkness—This movie is set to be released on March 30. This is the third move in this franchise. The first was really good—The second was ok—I'm hoping the third will not get worse. The premise appears to be that a pastor's church has been destroyed by a fire and his struggle to rebuild. This franchise has been good in showing how culture has attacked people of faith.

Mary Magdalene- This move is also set to be released on March 30 (Good Friday). It comes from Hollywood with A list stars. Rooney Mara portrays Mary Magdalene and Joaquin Phoenix portrays Jesus. I'm a little leery about Hollywood movies about faith because in the past few years movies about Noah and Moses have been poor. The preview I saw has Peter and Mary Magdalene having quite a bit of conflict between them. 
