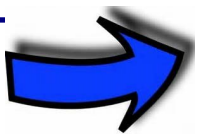
ANNUAL CATHOLIC APPEAL FOR 2019

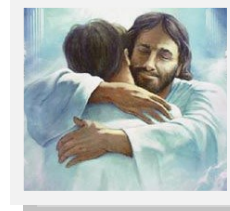

- **A COMMUNION SERVICE will be celebrated in the church at 10:00 am on that day.**



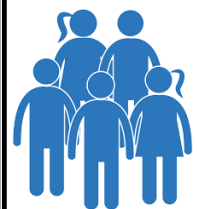
PRAYER VIGIL CANCELLED
