## New Student and Returning Student Fee

Our New Student Fee (\$175.00) and our Returning Student Fee (\$75.00) is due with your child's registration packet to hold a space for the 2022-2023 school year. This fee is non-refundable and non-transferable to another student or program and no exceptions will be made to this policy. Once this fee is paid, it will not be returned for any reason, cannot be used to pay tuition owed, and cannot be transferred to another student or sibling.

### **Annual Tuition**

Our annual tuition rates are as follows:

Two-day Program (Tuesdays and Thursdays) \$2100.00/year or ten (10) equal payments of \$210.00 Three-day Program (Mon., Wed., and Fri.) \$2950.00/year or ten (10) equal payments of \$295.00 Five-day Program \$3700.00/year or ten (10) equal payments of \$370.00

\*Tuition prices are calculated based on the number of days in school, with school closings and breaks removed from the total number. We also include a couple extra days for the occasional weather-related closing.

The first tuition payment of the year is due by August 15, 2022. Tuition should be paid in full at this point, or your #1 payment if you elect to pay in monthly installments. Monthly installment payments are then due the 15<sup>th</sup> of each of the following months, with the last payment due May 15<sup>th</sup>. Monthly installment payments are not for specific months, just a payment towards your annual total.

The prompt payment of tuition is essential to the proper functioning of our school. By signing this contract, you are agreeing to pay the tuition for the entire academic year and that no portion of the tuition will be forgiven or refunded on account of absences or school closures, including Covid related. If you elect to do monthly installments, payments not made by the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month will result in a \$20.00 late fee. If we do not receive your first payment by August 15th, your child's space will be given to a child on our waiting list. Payments not made by the 25<sup>th</sup> of the month will result in dismissal from Coastal Day School. If you encounter unexpected financial hardship, please notify us in writing as soon as possible so that we can explore possibilities of financial aid or rescheduling tuition payments.

Payments may be made by cash in person, or personal checks or debit/credit cards via our website. A \$20.00 fee will be assessed for any returned checks.

Coastal Day School requires at 30-day written notice if you plan to withdraw your child from our program for any reason. Tuition is required to be paid through the last day of the notice.

## Illness/COVID-19 Policy

In order to provide a safe and clean environment for all children at CDS parents MUST NOT bring their child if they are exhibiting any symptoms listed below:

- A temperature of 100 degrees or higher
- Red, watery eyes (pink eye)
- Undiagnosed rash
- Excessive runny nose/ sneezing
- Excessive cough
- Sore Throat
- Nausea/ Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Covid-19 or Flu Symptoms

Every child will have their temperature taken as they walk in the front door. Any child with a fever (100 degrees or higher) will not be permitted to stay. Children will immediately wash their hands prior to going into their classroom. For the time being, parents will not be permitted in classrooms. Drop off will need to happen at the front desk or drop-off line. Classroom materials, furniture, and toys will be sanitized daily, along with frequent handwashing. We will follow recommendations by the CDC, as they are made.

If any child or staff member tests positive for the coronavirus during the school year, we will notify everyone via email. We will need to follow any recommendations by health officials, so we are not sure what this will entail, but will communicate the details at that time. It could possibly mean being closed or a classroom quarantining. If a member of your household tests positive at any point, your child will not be permitted to return to school until they are released by the health department to do so. If a household member is awaiting test results, the child cannot attend.

As you are probably aware, closures during this pandemic have caused serious financial stress to our business, like many other businesses and families. It is our hope that we do not have to face those same closures this year, but that is unknown at this time. If we must close at any point due to a high number of cases in our school, or if your child is quarantining due to testing positive or exposure, tuition will not be prorated.

As a reminder, withdraw forms must be turned in by July 15, 2022 to avoid having to pay your first tuition payment on August 15, 2022, if you decide not to send your child. We do require a 30-day notice, to withdraw your child at any point in the school year, even during a closure for the coronavirus.

By signing below, I am confirming that I have been provided with a copy of Coastal Day School's Coronavirus Policy for the 2022-2023 school year and understand the policy in its entirety. I understand that sending my child to preschool/after school at CDS does come with the risk of exposure and possible infection of the coronavirus. I understand I will be responsible for paying tuition regardless of closures, or if your child is quarantining due to testing positive or exposure, and that the Withdraw Policy is still in affect during any closure.

# Coastal Day School Withdraw Policy

Here at CDS, we plan our entire year's budget on having every space filled. We know things come up such as moves, job changes, etc. that cause families to need to withdraw their child(ren) from our program. In order to keep our program's needs met, we require families to give us a one month notice as well as payment for that month. This gives us adequate time to fill the space with a new family. If you need to withdraw before the school year begins, we must receive notice in writing, by July 15<sup>th</sup>. If we do not receive notice by July 15<sup>th</sup>, you will still be required to pay the first tuition payment by August 15<sup>th</sup>. We do not allow students to withdraw after April 1<sup>st</sup>. We cannot fill a space with a new student so late in the year as it would cause disruptions to our learning. If your child will not be attending after April 1<sup>st</sup> for any reason, you are still required to pay the last two payments of the school year. ## Parent/Teacher/Administrator Communication

We strive to keep open communication between our families and staff to ensure all our student's needs are being met. We are a team, and to best advocate for and support the growth of our students, communication is essential. Below are some ways we do that, along with an outline of policies in place.

### **Teacher Emails**

Feel free to reach out to your child's teacher via email at any time. Their email address is their first name @coastaldayschool.com. We do ask our teachers to respond within 24 hours during the week. We do not require our teachers to respond over the weekend or during holiday breaks. Emails sent after 1pm on Friday will be answered Monday morning. If you need immediate assistance, it is best to reach out to an administrator as we try our best to respond as soon as possible. Our emails often get sent to spam folders so please check there if you are expecting an email from us.

## **Class Facebook Pages**

Each class has a private Facebook page that our teachers post pictures and updates to. This is a great place to see what your child is learning and see them having fun in class!! Only parents or guardians can be added to the private classroom pages. We will not approve grandparents or babysitters. Teachers will email out links to the private Facebook pages.

### Remind

We utilize the app Remind as a way to quickly relay information to the entire school in the event of an emergency or inclement weather. We also use it to send out reminders of upcoming deadlines, events, and celebrations. Some teachers also use Remind to send out class reminders. You will be added to our Remind groups, but you must accept by responding YES to the text you receive. You will not receive any information if you do not accept.
