Homeowner Regulations

Approved July 17, 2011

Purpose: A policy to inform Homeowners of regulations regarding the installation of portable air conditioners within their units.

I. Types of Air Conditioners

- 1. Indoor portable units with venting kits.
- 2. Window units are not allowed.

II. Requirements

- 1. Should be eco-friendly R410A refrigerant with zero Ozone Depletion Potential
- 2. Air Conditioner must sit inside unit, and not hang from a window.
- 3. An air conditioner that has a sliding glass door kit is permissible.
- 4. If air conditioner is vented through a wall, it must be vented in the back of the unit, below the height of the handrail on back deck.
- 5. All vents must be securely closed and insulated during the winter months to prevent cold air from entering units.
- 6. All vents must be installed so as not to let animals have access to units.
- 7. Homeowners must have a certified electrician make sure that the additional usage of an air conditioner will not be an overload on the existing circuit box and become a fire hazard.
