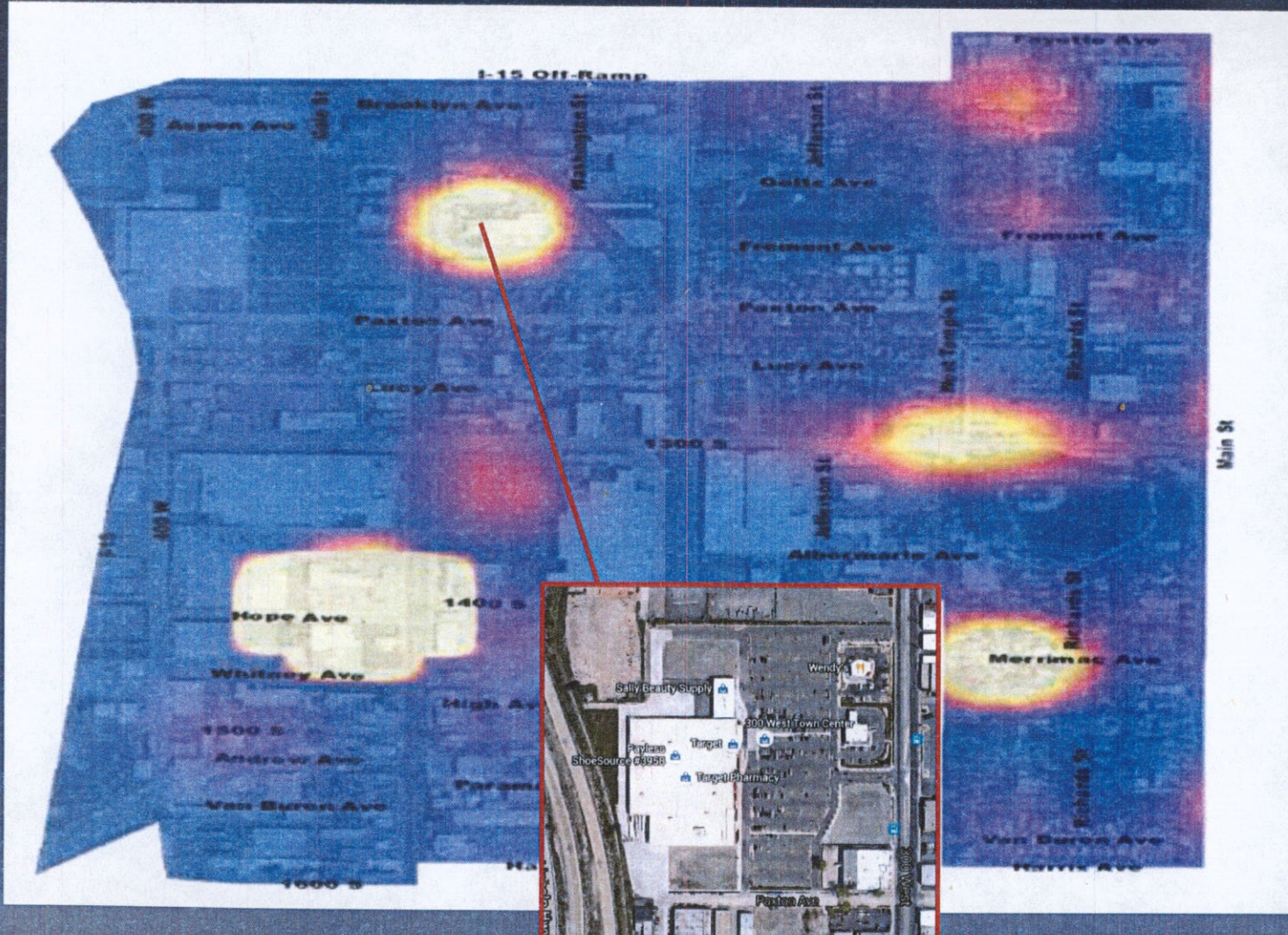
In 2014 . . .
