Palm Tree Accents

Note: It is the intent of the Design Review Board to limit the planting of Palm trees within Devonshire in accordance with City of Tampa criteria. A maximum of three (3) palms, each measuring 14" minimum DBH and eight feet clear trunk height will count towards one (1) canopy tree. It is recommended that palms only be used as accents to supplement the plantings of trees and to give appropriate scale to vertical structures.
