

Cecilia was a Roman noble woman who converted to Christianity in the early 200's. Her piety and example also led to the conversion of her husband Valerian. He and his brother were baptized by Pope Urban. At this time, there was an intense persecution of Christians throughout the city of Rome. Cecilia and Valerian were both arrested and sentenced to death. Cecilia is said to have beautifully sung praise and glory to God as she died. Her witness converted many Romans to Faith and she has since been known as the patron saint of music and musicians. St. Cecilia pray for us!
