

Evaluation of Instructional Program

The NWBOCES Board believes that continuous evaluation of the instructional program is a matter of utmost importance. The Big Horn Basin Children's Center educational offerings, methods, and techniques must serve the needs of the students. To help accomplish this, school professional personnel shall develop an evaluation program designed to:

1. Assess educational needs and provide information for planning
2. Indicate instructional strengths and weakness
3. Check the suitability of the programs in terms of needs and current clientele
4. Demonstrate the relationships between achievement and Big Horn Basin Children's Center's stated mission
5. Provide data for public information

The NWBOCES Board will rely on the professional staff to provide continuous evaluation of the educational program. The Board may participate with the professional staff in the evaluation process.

Outside agencies may be asked, with educational team approval, to conduct evaluations.
