General Information

Our Summer Camp Program promises a summer filled with fun! With weekly themes, field trips, special guests, and weekly water fun, your child will have a summer they'll never forget! We offer a safe, clean facility, qualified, experienced camp counselors, and low camper/staff ratios.

We are open ten weeks throughout the summer from 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. daily for children ages 5-12 years.

Campers are required to bring lunch, snacks, and drinks daily unless it is provided on a field trip which will be noted on the field trip calendar.

Campers should bring a bag daily with a bathing suit, towel, sunscreen, a change of clothes, and socks as our plans sometimes change unexpectedly.

Tuition is \$140.00/week per child for five days Monday-Friday, \$100.00/week per child for three days (Monday, Wednesday, and Friday), and \$70.00/week per child for two days (Tuesday and Thursday.)

Tuition includes all field trips and activities.

Tuition must be paid every
Monday for the current week.
Accounts will be charged for all
weeks that campers are
scheduled for regardless of
attendance. Refunds or
discounts will not be given for
missed days or field trips. A two
week minimum is required for
all campers. We offer a 15%
sibling discount for the second
child. All campers must
complete our registration form
and submit a \$30.00 nonrefundable camp fee.

Space is limited to 30 campers each day.

- Campers may bring electronics to use during down time when we are at the center. Coastal Day School is NOT responsible for any lost, stolen, or broken items from home and will not contact other parents in regards to stolen items.
 Campers are responsible for their own things.
- Campers need a morning snack, lunch, and afternoon snack as well as multiple drinks each day. You will need to send forks or spoons as well as condiments for your child's lunch each day. CDS does not have a kitchen or access to any dishes or utensils.
- We will be spending LOTS of time outside. Each child must bring one bottle of spray sunscreen each Monday morning (will stay at camp and be used for entire camp) and a water bottle each day! Hats and sunglasses are helpful as well!
- On water days and beach days, PLEASE send in flip-flops for your child. It's extremely hard to put tennis shoes on wet feet.

Camp Conduct

Campers are EXPECTED to be respectful to other campers, teachers, and equipment at all times. Campers will always be given a verbal warning to stop the behavior and teachers will give suggestions on how to make better choices. If an unacceptable behavior continues, the camper will take five in the office so they can reflect on their actions. If the unacceptable behavior continues after the take five, the camper's parents will be contacted to pick them up. If your child is asked to leave the program on any certain day, he/she is welcome to come back and try again the next day. However, after being asked to leave 3 times, the child will not be able to come back and complete the Summer Camp program.

* If a child displays ANY form of physical contact with another child or teacher, he/she will be suspended for the remainder of the week. The child is then allowed back at CDS however, if any physical contact is performed again, the child will NOT be allowed to come back and participate for the rest of Summer Camp at CDS. We have a no-tolerance policy at CDS when it comes to physical contact or bullying.

**Tuition will NOT be refunded for missed days or weeks due to behavior.
