Youth llama must enter either Novice/Advanced or Youth class, not both.

Non Breeder - Show DOB on entry form, class may be split depending on numbers.

Classes may be combined or separated as needed.

Animals will NOT be moved to a different wool class after entry is made. Animals may only be moved by the judge to a different wool division.

Be sure to have the llama's ILR number when entering the show. "Pending" is not acceptable. Alpacas may be entered in showmanship and performance.

Llamas/alpacas coming from out-of-state need a health certificate issued within 30 days before the show.

Production Pair: 2 offspring from same Dam or Sire, any age or sex. Enter name and ILR # of Dam or Sire and indicate entered llamas to be used. \$3 ILR fee required for each Dam or Sire.

A lunch stand will be available on site.

Camping is available.

Please clean your stall(s) before leaving.

Entry deadline: postmarked by April 22, 2022
