KEY WEST PRIDE 2020 is not happening in June because of COVID-19, but the annual parade and celebration have a new date of November 18-22, 2020. How will One Island Family participate this year??

INVITATION TO GROUPS:

With Board approval, One Island Family will begin on June 1, 2020 to reopen our building to the groups who previously held programs in our sanctuary (Forever Young, Mindful Movement, Pilates, Yoga, and Sangha). The invitation to return will require the leader of each group to read and follow the

Key West Directive on Gyms and Fitness Centers (https://www.cityofkeywest-fl.gov/egov/documents/1589807337_4794.pdf). That includes limiting class size, temperature taking, monitoring social distancing , cleaning equipment (chairs, table surfaces, etc.), providing water bottles, and disinfecting after each session. Each group will be asked to provide hand sanitizers and wipes for their class.

Before resuming the first classes, each group will be asked to sanitize any mats or equipment now stored in the building. After each session, the participants will be expected to take home any equipment such as hand weights, towels, or small cushions, so that these personal items are not stored in our closet.

By June 1, One Island Family will sanitize the chairs and table surfaces. Our professional cleaning service, Excel, will resume weekly cleaning as the activities begin again. We are mindful that many of us in the One Island Family congregation are part of the vulnerable population which has received protection from the stay at home orders initiated in March.
