Skater Incentive Program  
July 1, 2017-June 30, 2018

The skater competition incentive program is designed to reward Birmingham FSC full child and adult skating members for participation in USFS sanctioned competitions, tests passed and BFSC events (Social and introductory members are not eligible. Skating members that have received funds for regionals, sectionals or nationals during the incentive year are not eligible.) The following formula awards points to skaters based on the various competitions and functions in which BFSC skaters participate.

The basic formula accumulates all points earned by BFSC skaters (the Skater Point Total). The total funds available are divided by the total of all skater points. This gives a dollar Value to each point. Each skater will receive a subsidy equal to their individual Skater Point Total multiplied by the dollar Value for 2017-2018.

Key Points:

1. No single skater or team shall receive a reward greater than one-fifth of the total funds allocated for each competition season.
2. Points shall be calculated for all eligible BFSC skaters annually (July 1 – June 30). An eligible skater is any BFSC skater who is a primary member of the club in good standing on June 30th of the year during which the rewards are accumulated.
3. Points can only be earned for USFS sanctioned events. ISI events are not eligible.
4. Skaters should complete the Incentive Program form at the end of the membership year. **RESULT SHEETS MUST BE ATTACHED FOR AT LEAST ONE EVENT FROM EACH COMPETITION.**
5. Skaters must attach copy of testing sheet for each test passed and test date.
6. Skaters will receive one additional point for advancing from an initial to a final round of any QUALIFYING competition.
7. A minimum of 10 volunteer hours with the BFSC by the skater and/or the skater's family members is required to receive these funds. Volunteer time sheets must be turned in with the Incentive Program form, but should be filled out and signed at the time the volunteer activity is completed.
8. Skaters must attend at least 50% of BFSC functions (i.e. Club nights, Annual Awards Banquet and the Annual General Membership Meeting). Attendance will be taken at each event.
9. Skaters who are participating members of the Junior Board of the BFSC will receive 1 additional point.
