

BAND BOOSTER COMMITTEES

SPIRIT COMMITTEE

Popsicles: Handed out after practice on Thursdays – please provide popsicles (300) bring scissors – Popsicles take a few days to freeze – please plan ahead – remove from box or they may not freeze. Need a committee chair typically 2 volunteers needed to distribute the popsicles. We need about 20 volunteers, 10 dates.

Senior Night: Friday, November 10th, Typically 1 – 2 volunteers need to line students and their families up in order, we need a photographer (have had services donated in the past) and we have had a parent volunteer to provide carnations for each senior. The picture taken on senior night is framed and gifted to the students during Band Banquet.

Poster Making – Monday, October 3rd during band practice – placed all over the band hall and hallways prior to marching contests in October. Please bring posters, markers and supplies. The more the merrier! It is a lot of fun!

Tailgate: Friday, October 27th. Begins after school, need volunteers to coordinate food/drink for the students. Approximately 10 – 15 volunteers needed.

Fair Day: Friday, September 29th. Need assistance with setting up and serving food after the parade and before the students head to the fairgrounds. Typically need 10 – 15 volunteers.

Pit Crew: Need volunteers especially for Competition Season and to ensure our PIT has enough people to assist them moving the gear.

BAND BANQUET COMMITTEE

Saturday April 14, 2018. Committee coordinates food, drink, entertainment, décor and recognition of outgoing officers. Assist band directors in recognizing achievements of the Senior Band students – must operate within the budget set forth by the band booster club. Approximately 15 – 20 volunteers needed for the night of the event.

UNIFORM WASHING

Parent volunteers typically wash marching uniforms 3 times during the year. We have each volunteer take 10 uniforms home. There are approximately 300 students, so we need 30 volunteers for each wash, 90 volunteers in total. Additionally, we wash 100 concert dresses once a year and need 10 volunteers to each wash 10 dresses. By washing the uniforms

ourselves it saves the band over \$10,000 per year. Both are very easy to wash: cold wash gentle and hang dry.

WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Committee organizes all fundraisers (not including Wurstfest and WGI) and business sponsorships. Last year this committee raised money which is directly used to enhance all band students. If you own a business or know of a business interested in sponsoring the band, please let us know.

HOLIDAY PERCUSSION & JAZZ - SPAGHETTI CONCERT/DINNER COMMITTEE

Monday, December 11th. Coordinate the purchase/donation/serving of food and drinks, silent auction and dessert table. This committee raises money for the Jazz & Percussion program at Canyon. Typically need at least 20 volunteers.

WGI COMMITTEE

Winter Guard International has allowed our High School to hold this even – great fundraising opportunities for the boosters. Need volunteers to coordinate the purchase/donation/selling food and sponsorships in advance. Day of coordination of parking, concessions, hospitality for judges and assisting participants. Proceeds in the past have been more than a typical Wurstfest Day. Typically need at least 50 volunteers.

NOMINATING COMMITTEE

This committee consists of the Booster President, a chairperson and a non-associate parent. Nominate individuals to fill each elected office – with their permission.

AUDIT COMMITTEE

This committee consists a chairperson and 2 members responsible for insuring the Treasurer's financial records and organized funds are audited in June of each year/also responsible for performing audits whenever a Treasurer resigns or is terminated and at any other items deemed necessary by the Executive Board.
