

Election Integrity Project California Citizen Incident Statement Instructions

What is an Incident?

Actions and/or comments by Election Officials that resulted in you or others to have difficulty casting a vote or not being able to cast a vote at all.

Examples of Incidents: Report if...

- ...you or someone you know were not on the check-in roster at your polling place
- ...you or someone you know was sent away from the polling location without voting
- ...you or someone you know was forced to vote with a provisional ballot
- ...actions by election officials that were inappropriate in the polls or at the office
- ...you or someone you know had your voter registration changed without your knowledge or permission

These are just examples.

Your experience or observation may not match but are very important. Sharing your experience will help us determine the wide range of issues that are of concern to a fair and honest electoral process. It may also provide the evidence needed to prove wrongdoing.

How Do I Complete the Reports?

- 1) Fully complete the **Incident Report form.**
- 2) Print legibly or type on a separate piece of paper and staple it to the form.
- 3) Report facts ONLY not your opinions, your judgment, or your emotions!
- 4) Quotes be sure to use quotation marks when quoting what someone said.
- 5) Complete the Declaration at the bottom of the Report.
- 6) Sign Your Name in blue ink where indicated at the bottom of the page
- Mail the Incident Report, a copy of both sides of ballot envelopes addressed to the wrong person, your own misprinted ballot, duplicates, and other materials to:

Make a copy of each Incident Report and Witness Statements for your records.



EIPCa Citizen Incident Statement
