STEWARDSHIP

Gratitude in Action: Our Way of Life

When we speak of Stewards, we identify someone who is God-centered, someone whose focus is on God's will in their life and what must be done to fulfill that will. A Steward is not focused on self.

Stewards know God provides all, even though we may call it ours. We receive what He gives us and care for everything in a responsible manner. We know we have received His gifts, not because we have earned them, but because God loves us.

God asks us in turn to share these gifts with others. When we share them from our hearts, whether they are gifts of time, talent or money, we are returning to God, through our generosity to others, what He has so lovingly bestowed upon us.

Unlike James and John in today's Gospel, Stewards do not ask God to do "whatever" we request of Him. Instead, we seek to know God's will and carry it out, regardless of what He asks. We seek to follow in Jesus' footsteps, to serve wherever and in whatever manner we are called. We do not seek to be served, but rather as Jesus chose, we seek to serve those who need us.

Saint Paul chose to be a slave of Jesus Christ. Jesus chose to serve others, rather than be served. Humility is the virtue by which each chose to live, just as we also must choose if we hope to attain eternal joy with God in Heaven.

*"We begin to pray the two major sections of the Peace Prayer— "Lord...Divine Master"—and the ground beneath our feet immediately begins to move. We realize and acknowledge that the universe was not designed to revolve around me and my petty wants and desires. Indeed, by virtue of my baptism, I am called to walk in the footprints of Jesus who, in emptying himself, surrendering and serving God's will, has become the Lord and Divine Master of the universe."*¹

The virtue of humility, its wisdom and strength, will guide us courageously on our earthly journey as we strive to live out the Gospel in our lives. Jesus, our way, our truth and our life, is our reason to take up our cross daily and follow in His footsteps, so we may come to know joy and peace with Him for all eternity.
