### Psychology of Aging

Join us for a stimulating discussion of aging and its effects on our individual attitudes. The speaker will be Ryan C.W. Hall representing UCF and University of South Florida in Tampa.

### Biography of Ryan C. W. Hall, MD

Dr. Ryan C. W. Hall graduated Phi Beta Kappa with honors with a double major in Biology and Psychology from Johns Hopkins University. He completed his medical training at Georgetown University School of Medicine. He completed his psychiatric residency in the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences at Johns Hopkins and a forensic psychiatry fellowship at the Case Western Reserve School of Medicine.

In 2005, he received the Dorfman Award from the Academy of Psychosomatic Medicine for the best review article of the year. In 2006, he was named a Rappeport Fellow from the American Academy of Psychiatry and the Law. In 2009, he was selected by peers to be included in *Best Doctors in America*. Dr. Hall has been selected to serve as the American Academy of Psychiatry and the Law's Young Physician Delegate to the American Medical Association in 2010.

Dr. Hall serves as an Affiliate Assistant Professor for the University of South Florida's Department of Psychiatry in Tampa, Florida, as well as an Assistant Professor of Psychiatry for the Department of Medical Education at the University of Central Florida College of Medicine in Orlando, Florida. Dr. Hall also serves as an Adjunct Faculty Member at the Barry University Dwayne O. Andreas School of Law in Orlando, Florida.

Dr. Hall has published more than 38 scientific articles and has made more than 50 major clinical presentations. He serves as a reviewer for ten major medical journals.




