



El Santuario de Los Pobladores (The Sanctuary of the Settlers) is a committee of Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish established for the purpose of creating a magnificent arts center, an"adobe" sanctuary. The labyrinth is to be constructed out of adobe, the ancient earthen building technique brought to the San Luis Valley by the early settlers to this part of Southern Colorado, and will be built next to Our Lady of Guadalupe Church in Conejos, the oldest parish in Colorado.

There will be 20 resting places, small shrines or nichos along the way sculpted in bronze depicting all 20 occurrences in the life of Christ & The Blessed Mother. In the garden area outside the labyrinth, celebrating the Faith of our ancestors, a bronze statue of each community's patron saint will be displayed. Our Lady of Guadalupe will be manifested in bronze at the entrance of the labyrinth as the special mother of all Latinos in the New World.





OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE PARISH




THEME: Be Watchful!

"At the mystery of his Nativity... may he [the Lord Jesus] find us watchful in prayer and exultant in his praise" (Preface II of Advent).
