SIMPLE HOLY HOUR PART II

Last weekend I told you that beginning **Sunday November 5th I** will have daily simple Holy Hours scheduled. The schedule is as follows:

Sunday- 2 p.m.- 3 p.m. @ St. Joseph Monday- 10 p.m.- 11 p.m. @St. Joseph Tuesday- 8:30 a.m.- 9:30 a.m. @St. Joseph Wednesday- 10 p.m.- 11p.m. @St. Joseph (Except on monthly Holy Hours at 7pm) Thursday-8:30 a.m.-9:30 a.m. @ St. Joseph Friday- 2:15 p.m.- 3:15 p.m. @ Sacred Heart Saturday- 2:30 p.m.- 3:30 p.m. @ Sacred Heart

You can cut out the above schedule and put it on your refrigerator as a reminder for you in the future. I am sorry that Sacred Heart parish only has two days for the week, but since I live at St. Joseph parish it is more convenient for my daily schedule to have most of the days and times at St. Joseph.

As a reminder, there are several opportunities to pray in front of the Blessed Sacrament during the week. Tuesdays during the week there is a group that prays for our country from 11 a.m.- Noon. Thursday the students of St. Joseph School come together for a Holy 15 minutes at 1:30 p.m. Fridays the students of Sacred Heart school come together at 2:15 p.m. for a Holy 15 minutes as well. I decided to incorporate the Sacred Heart school prayer time as part of the simple Holy Hour, so the first 15 minutes will not be silent.

The morning Holy Hours for St. Joseph will have all the doors to the church open, but the late night Holy Hours will only have the ramp door and the south door facing the office open. Monday is my day off and sometimes I'm driving back from Toledo and get back to Crestline late in the day so that is why the time for Monday is late. We typically have a formal Holy Hour on the first Wednesday of the month so that will always replace the 10 p.m. time for Wednesday.

When one of the simple Holy Hours must be cancelled or the time changed it will be noted in the bulletin. Obvious times for this happening are holiday and vacation days among other things. I will review the simple Holy Hour schedule after three months to determine if the schedule is working for me and/or if times need to be changed.

St. Teresa of Calcutta once told her Sisters of Charity that they needed to have a daily Holy Hour. Some of the sisters said that they had too much to do every day to have a daily Holy Hour. But when St. Teresa insisted on it the sisters found out that as a fruit of the daily Holy Hour they could do their ministries with more efficiency and accomplish more than they thought they could. God is Good!

Holy Hour


