- Last to enter, first to compete and "fill in" for Reels.
- All dancers must present their 2017 FUSTA/ ScotDance card at the time of registration. Dancers without card must fill out "No Card" form. Awards won will remain with organizer until proof of card is shown.
- Perpetual trophies for special events are the property of the Kerr County Celtic Association and must be returned prior to the following year's event. Winners are responsible for engraving
- Entries must be postmarked by **WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 20<sup>th</sup>, 2017.**
- Late entries will be accepted until **OCTOBER 1<sup>st</sup>** with an additional late fee of \$25
