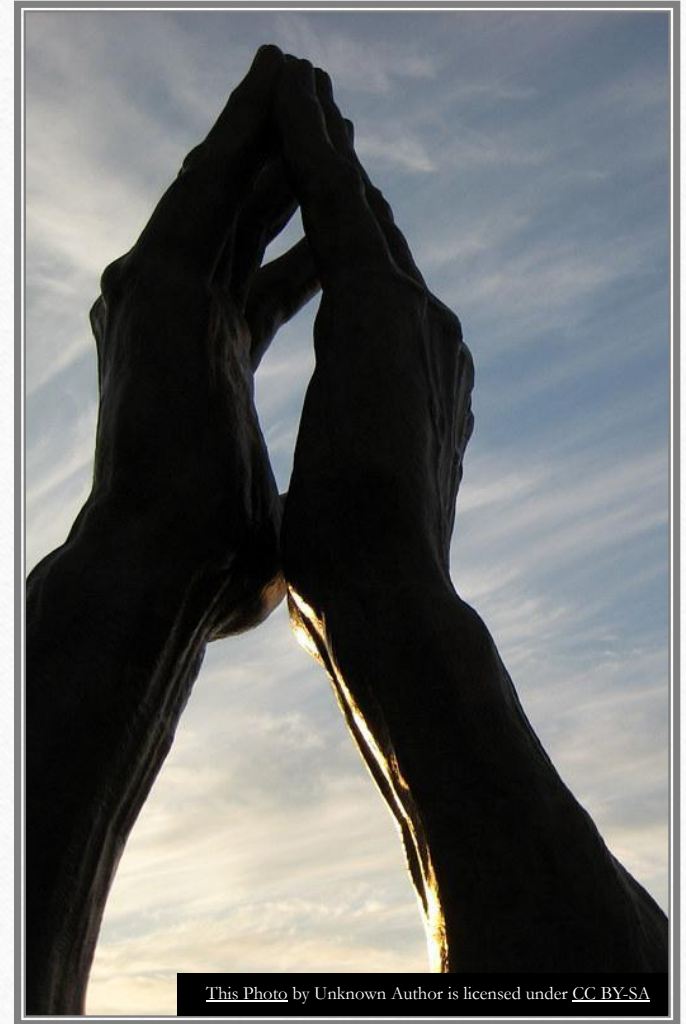

UNISON PRAYER OF CONFESSION

Give us this day our daily bread.

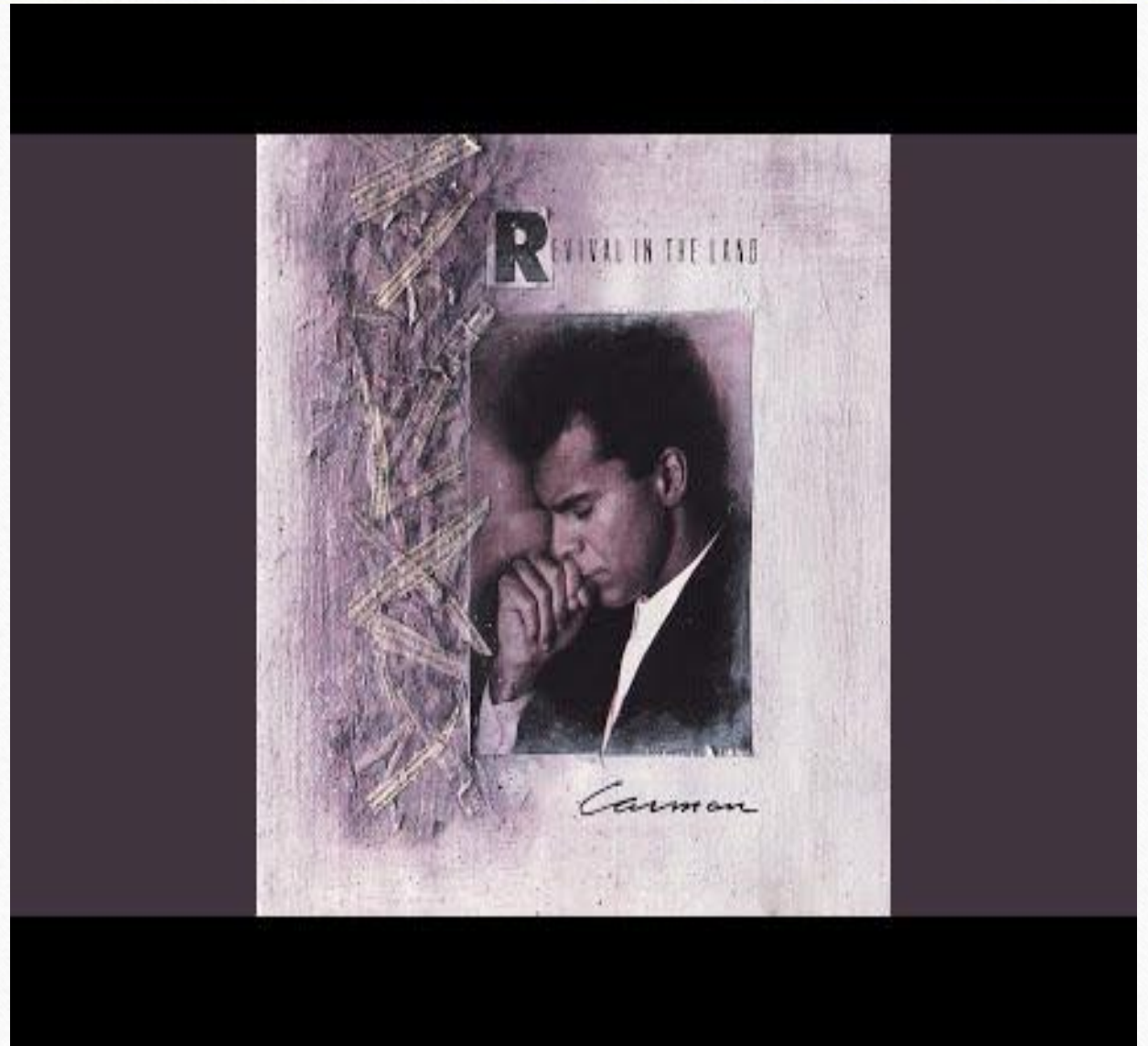
**And forgive us our trespasses,
