

## CHAMPIONS CENTER

### BIO SAFETY GUIDELINES

In association with the Clark County Health Department and the State of Ohio Health Department Orders, the Show Management hosting an event at the Champions Center is required to enact the following at minimum for show staff, exhibitors and spectators:

- All persons must enter the Champions Center via Laybourne Rd. entrance also marked as “Gate D”
- Trailers/campers must be parked with doors facing AWAY from each other, trailers/campers parked with doors facing each other will be asked to move
- Trailers/campers must be parked at least 6 feet apart
- **Everyone is required to wear a face mask/covering in any setting where there is a possibility of being within six feet of any other individual, except when mounted on a horse, driving a horse, or seated while dining**
- Exhibitors are required to practice social distancing (at least 6 feet) throughout the entire event, in the facility AND in the camping area
- Large gatherings of 10 or more people will not be allowed in camping area OR stall aisles
- Show management must provide hand sanitation in various locations throughout the indoor and outdoor stall barns (where applicable)
- Traffic in the show office will be limited to show personnel only. Entries will be taken through the front window of the show office
- Depending on weather, all overhead doors in the facility will remain open at all times to ensure ventilation and air flow
- Each individual show may provide their own list of guidelines and we ask everyone to comply with those as well
- Show management is responsible for ensuring that all exhibitors and attendees are in compliance with all of these above items
