<u>Virtus / Electronic Fingerprinting</u>: Family members who would like to volunteer at school must first complete all steps of the Archdiocese of Washington's Virtus Child Protection Program. Info & forms are available from the School Office. ADW has replaced Virtus's Electronic Background Check with Electronic Fingerprinting, and requires **ALL** volunteers to complete this by January 2020. Volunteers who have completed all the previous steps **MUST** have their electronic fingerprints done by January to continue volunteering in 2020. REMINDERS:

ART CLASSES

Last Thursday & Friday were our first Art classes with our new Art teacher, Mrs. Amy Carter. The younger children's work was inspired by the Russian painter Wassily Kandinsky. Students reviewed types of lines (vertical, horizontal, diagonal), as well as primary, secondary, neutral, and complementary colors, and then used these to create wax resist paintings.







Our middle schoolers created art inspired by American painter Jasper Johns, and based on American artist Robert Indiana's "Love" sculpture. Their work involved sketching, painting, and using pencil erasers to create designs in the paint.
