

### CAM'S CORNER

It seems that all I can talk about is some kind of backup either from the toilets or from the kitchen sinks. This time it is about the kitchen sinks. We have been seeing an awful lot of grease in these lines that seem to be causing the pipes to back up. I ask that you not put any grease down these drains, but I know that is impossible to do. So, I would like to ask that any grease in excess be put into the garbage rather than down the drains. You will still have grease on your dishes, but use a detergent that dispenses the grease such as Dawn and do your dishes in really hot water. We need all the help we can get to keep these backups from occurring so frequently. Last month my article discussed a baking soda/vinegar way to clean out your drains, use this frequently and maybe this will help this problem. Thank you for your assistance with this problem.
