REVELATION 1:3; 17-20

¹The **revelation from Jesus Christ**, which God gave him **to show his servants what must soon take place**. He made it known by sending his angel to his servant John, ² who testifies to everything he saw—that is, **the word of God** AND **the testimony of Jesus Christ**.

³ BLESSED IS THE ONE WHO READS ALOUD THE WORDS OF THIS PROPHECY AND BLESSED ARE THOSE WHO HEAR IT AND TAKE TO HEART WHAT IS WRITTEN IN IT, BECAUSE THE TIME IS NEAR.

¹⁷ When I saw him, I fell at his feet as though dead. Then he placed his right hand on me and said: "Do not be afraid. I am the First and the Last. ¹⁸ I am the Living One; I was dead, and now look, I am alive for ever and ever! And I hold the keys of death and Hades.

¹⁹ "Write, THEREFORE, what you have seen, what is now and what will take place later. ²⁰ The mystery of the seven stars that you saw in my right hand and of the seven golden lampstands is this: The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches, and the seven lampstands are the seven churches."

A SUMMARY OF REVELATION 1-3

The book of Revelation is a Revelation of the Glorified and Resurrected Jesus...AND OF Jesus' words to the church.

I believe that Revelation is **intended to be our resurrected Lord's word to encourage and prepare the church for the 'days to come'** ... there will be calamities and trials of all sorts And in the darkest moments ... God's angels and intercessors will strengthen and empower and enable the church to persevere UNTIL THE DAY THAT JESUS WILL COME AGAIN and MAKE ALL THINGS RIGHT ...

IN THIS WORLD WE WILL EXPERIENCE: MATTHEW 24:6-13

⁶ You will hear of wars and rumors of wars but see to it that you are not alarmed. Such things must happen, but the end is still to come. ⁷ Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. There will be famines and earthquakes in various places. ⁸ All these are the beginning of birth pains.

⁹ Then you will be handed over to be persecuted and put to death, and you will be hated by all nations because of me.¹⁰ At that time many will turn away from the faith and will betray and hate each other, ¹¹ and many false prophets will appear and deceive many people. ¹² Because of the increase of wickedness, the love of most will grow cold,¹³ but the one who stands firm to the end will be saved.

BUT WHAT IS REALLY OCCURRING IS: EPHESIANS 6:12-13

¹²For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.

¹³ Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand.
