

This year we mark the centenary of the end of World War 1. On Remembrance Sunday 11 November 2018, people around the Commonwealth will be remembering the bravery of those who fought, lived and died in the First World War.

Our speaker, a serving member of the Royal Air Force for 18 years, came to faith 9 years ago following an invitation to a church in Lincoln by a friend.
