AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MARION, CENTRE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ADOPTING A NAME FOR THE MARION TOWNSHIP BALLFIELD IN MARION TOWNSHIP COMMUNITY PARK LOCATED ALONG JACKSONVILLE ROAD, S.R. 26, TO BE THE "LT. JONAS M. PANIK FIELD".

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors in and for the Township of Marion, Centre County, Pennsylvania as follows:
