## DIRECTIONS



1. Lay out wood pieces on newspaper/plastic.
2. Gather water and a paper towel. Always wash and dry your brush when changing colors.
3. Paint background using a big brush. (Usually either white or black, so you can go crazy with the colors on the letters)
4. Let dry \& recoat if necessary. A little paint goes a long way, make sure to brush out any big chunks of paint.
5. Use a small brush to paint small wood pieces. Choose any colors you wish, mix colors on a plate. A LITTLE PAINT GOES A LONG UAY
Yellow + blue = green
Yellow + red = orange
Red + blue = purple
Use white to lighten any color
6. Let dry and apply second coat as needed.
7. Once all pieces are dry, glue together.
8. Use string or metal bracket to hang artwork.
