

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Lay out wood pieces on newspaper/plastic.
- 2. Gather water and a paper towel. Always wash and dry your brush when changing colors.
- 3. Paint background using a big brush. (Usually either white or black, so you can go crazy with the colors on the letters)
- 4. Let dry & recoat if necessary. A little paint goes a long way, make sure to brush out any big chunks of paint.
- 5. Use a small brush to paint small wood pieces. Choose any colors you wish, mix colors on a plate. A LITTLE PAINT GOES A LONG WAY

Yellow + blue = green

Yellow + red = orange

Red + blue = purple

Use white to lighten any color

- 6. Let dry and apply second coat as needed.
- 7. Once all pieces are dry, glue together.
- 8. Use string or metal bracket to hang artwork.
