JACK'S CORNER



“ARE YOU A MINIMALIST?”

In today's world many have accumulated so many material things that these things have actually become a burden to them.

Have you noticed all the storage buildings being constructed? This is greatly due to people having to store their possessions because they have an overload, and have run out of room in their houses.

Because of this problem, some have decided to become “minimalists.” They get rid of the excess and only keep a minimal amount of their belongings.

Spiritually speaking, it appears that a good number of “Christians” have become minimalists. They give a minimal amount of time to worship services and Bible classes. They give a minimal amount of time (or no time) to the work of the church. They have an attitude of doing the least that they believe God requires.

Here is a self-check test to determine where we stand:

- (1) Do I reason that the Bible only requires me to worship on Sunday? It doesn't matter that the elders have set aside Sunday and Wednesday nights to help in my spiritual growth.
- (2) Do I reason that I have no talents; the church doesn't need me anyway?
- (3) Am I able to teach another how to become a Christian? Or, am I ashamed of the gospel?
- (4) Do I read my Bible daily?
- (5) Do I pray daily?
- (6) Can I forgive those who have hurt me?
- (7) Do I see myself as an essential part of this congregation?

“Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away; and every branch that bears fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit...If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned (John 15:2, 5).
