Horse Show Supply List

Necessities:

- horse/pony
 - o your horse/pony MUST be clipped and ready for the show ring
- shipping wraps
- lead rope for shipping and transporting around show grounds
- leather halter for shipping and transporting around show groups
- saddle
- fitted saddle pad(s)
- schooling saddle pad(s)
- bridle, martingale, a CLEAN bit for the ring, etc.
- leather girth, brand-new-looking fuzzy girth, or brown non-slip girth
- approved helmet
 - o approved helmet brands include: Ovation, Charles Owens, OneK, and Samshield
- hairnets or ribbons (your trainer will be able to tell you which one you need)
- tall boots or jodhpur straps (your trainer will be able to tell you which one you need)
- tan show breeches (or other equivalent well-conditioned tan breeches)
- long sleeved show shirt(s) with collar
- show jacket (preferably navy or black)
- belt
- grooming equipment (don't forget the mane and tail brushes!!)
- snacks and drinks (in a cooler) to share
- chair to sit in during down time
 - o the barn does not have enough to accommodate everyone at all times
- cash to tip the grooms (recommended \$20 per day)
- lunge line
- poultice
- rearm (horse ear puffies)
- fly spray
- show sheen
- liniment
- bathing equipment (shampoo, bucket, sweat scraper, sponge, etc.)
- bell boots
- standard sized tack box (larger tack boxes will be your responsibility to transport)
- black or dark purple cover for tack box
- seam ripper for braids (like the ones you use for sewing)
- tack cleaner and conditioner
- boot polish
- cross ties for your stall (if your horse requires them)
- rain gear (rain boots, raincoat, rain pants, etc.)
- a cooler for your horse (remember: our barn colors are black, purple, and cream)
- pajama pants or oversized sweatpants (to wear over show pants so they do not get dirty throughout the day if wearing show pants all day)
