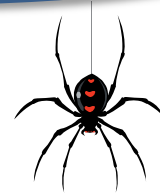

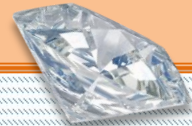

Membership Benefits

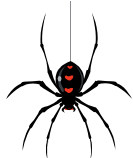
