COURSE OF FIRE

You are responsible for turning in all paper targets you do shoot as soon as you have finished shooting them. This will help with the scoring and speed up the awarding of prizes on Sunday. After you have shot all the gongs, please turn in your score cards as soon as possible. The tie breaker target is to be shot by everyone. We will use it to break any and all ties.

- 2. 50 yd (10 shots) 50 yd Pistol Target 8 ring black
- 3. 10 steel targets 1 shot at each. They will be designated on the gong range as pistol targets.
- one or two hands allowed
 • revolvers allowed

Trade Gun Aggregate (Paper and gongs) 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place

- 1. 25 yd (5 shots) 100 yd MLRA rifle target
- 2. 50 yd (5 shots) 200 yd MLRA target
- 3. 10 steel targets 1 shot at each. They will be designated on the gong range as trade gun.

SQUIRREL GUN AGGREGATE (paper) (40 Cal. Or less), 1st, 2nd, 3rd Place 3 different SQUIRREL TARGETS 5 shots each target All at 25 yds.

Rules & General Information

These are the rules we will be using for this rendezvous. Safety is our first priority at any of our rendezvous, so please read the rules and follow them throughout this entire weekend of fun and shooting. If you have any questions, please feel free to ask any of the club's members. They will try to help you any way they can.

Rules and Range Safety

- 1. Ear & eye protection shall be worn by everyone on the <u>firing line</u>, shooter or non-shooter.
- 2. No loading or firing until the range officer has given the "Commence loading, you may fire when ready" command.
- 3. The range officer will call a "Cease Fire" after the time limit has expired.
- 4. Anyone can call a "Cease Fire" if they see an unsafe condition down range of the firing line.
- 5. No smoking on the firing line.
- 6. No drinking of intoxicating beverages on the firing line.
- 7. During a "Cease Fire" all firearms must be placed in a safe position with the muzzle pointing up. No one will handle their firearms while anyone is down range.
- 8. No blowing down the barrel of any firearm.
- 9. Maintain muzzle control at all times, do not point your firearm in an unsafe direction at any time.
- 10. Pop a cap after the load and fire command with the muzzle pointed down range.
- 11. Do not load directly from the powder horn. Always load from a separate powder measure.
- 12. Load only from the loading bench and do not cap or prime your gun until stepping to the firing line.

General Information

Ranges open at 9:00 AM, Range closes 3:00 PM.

Trail walk and Archery walk can be done after 3:00 PM Thursday thru Saturday and Sunday morning.

All shots are patched round ball.

All relays will be 30 min.

This is a rendezvous and we would like to see as many as possible dress for the occasion in primitive clothing.

Saturday evening at 5:30PM is the Bar-B-Q potluck. We are furnishing pot roast and potatoes, your ticket to attend is 1 side dish. Anyone not registered to shot and wishing to attend must bring a potluck dish and pay 10.00 a person. This fee does not include family members of registered shooters as long as 1 side dish is furnished by participating shooter.

Awards will be presented on Sunday at 12:30 PM.
