New Year Resolutions from the Master

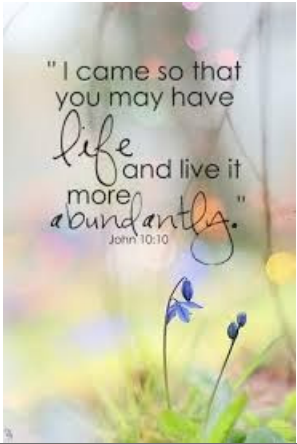
