As discussed in the prior council meeting, the Solicitor was apprised of the issue and finding from the Logan County Metropolitan Housing inspection. Solicitor Dinkler prepared a resolution to terminate the lease in a manner that is beneficial for both the tenant and the village. If council is agreeable to the terms outlined in the resolution, Ms. Dinkler will prepare a formal agreement. If the tenant is not agreeable, then the solicitor suggests that council start the process of eviction.

Mr. Huffman voiced concerns that affordable rentals are not available and that the tenant would not have anywhere to go. Given the condition of the property and the fact that the tenant was immediately notified that they should start looking into other living arrangements when the village took possession of the property, other council members agreed that further action needs to be taken to vacate the property.
