

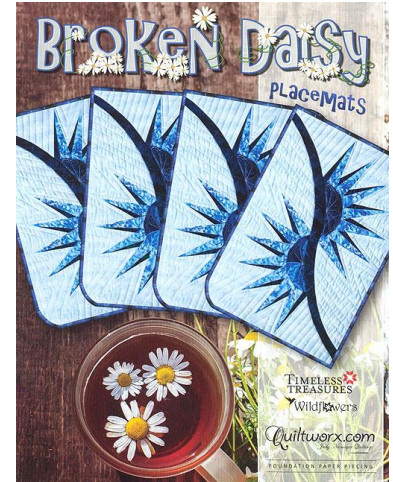
Broken Daisy Supply List and Pre-Class Instructions

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The Broken Daisy Placemats are a fun easy to complete project that come out just beautiful and can be done in MANY different colorways. This class is GREAT for beginners! A sewing technique called foundation paper piecing is used to assemble the units required to make this quilt. Curved piecing is used to join the units after the foundation piecing is completed and the way I will show you to do it is easy-peasy!!!! Make some for your gift giving today.



Supplies

- ◆ Broken Daisy Pattern by Judy Niemeyer
- ◆ Fabric Yardage Listed on Pattern Sheet
 - ❖ **Rule of thumb:** When choosing fabrics, it is best **not** to have directional fabrics in this quilt. Also, consider choosing high contrast colors for the greatest effect.
- ◆ Water Soluble Fabric Glue **Pen (not liquid)**
- ◆ UHU Glue Stick or water soluble glue stick
- ◆ (1) One or Two Gallon Size Ziplock bag
- ◆ One box of Large Paper clips, a pencil, scotch tape and a stapler comes in handy
- ◆ Template Plastic for a folding template
- ◆ Add a Quarter ruler – 12” (18” is also fine)
- ◆ Purple Thang
- ◆ Quilting Ruler
- ◆ Small Iron and ironing pad
- ◆ Rotary cutter (with a new blade in it!) and Rotary cutting mat
- ◆ Fabric scissors and paper scissors
- ◆ Flat head pins (best for paper piecing)
- ◆ Sewing machine (Don't forget the power supply and foot pedal! If you have a 1/4” foot, please bring it.)
- ◆ Sewing supplies
 - Thread – color that will blend with your fabrics. I recommend Aurifil in a cream color.
 - Bobbins – it's best to fill several bobbins with the appropriate color thread prior to class
 - Seam ripper

Pre-Class Instructions

- Tape your fabric swatches on p. 4 of the instructions where it says “fabric swatch”
- Using fabric A1, cut (4) 17” x 30” pieces and put them in bag #1
- Using fabric A2, cut (2) 8 ¼” x WOF (Width of Fabric) strips and place in bag #1
- Using fabric A3 , cut (2) 6 ½” x WOF strips and place in bag #1
- Using fabric A4, cut (1) 2 ½ X WOF strip and place in bag #1
