A Note From Rick: Stronger markets across the board on Tuesday at TLA. Butcher cows were a little stronger than they have been the last few weeks. A big reason for that strength, in my opinion, came from the fact that we had better cows to sell. The calf market continued its recent strength with the better Holstein bull calves ranging from \$1.30 to \$1.80 and Crossbred calves from \$2.00 to \$2.60. We had a nice run of Holstein replacement heifers ranging from 600 to 900 lbs. The market was stronger, ranging from \$.95/lb to \$1.00 per lb. This market is being driven by the higher feeder cattle prices. The majority of these cattle went to the feedlot and won't be dairy cattle when it's all said and done. The Dairy cattle market continues to be unchanged for the most part. There is a slight demand for the very top end of springers and fresh cows, but very little demand for the average and below average cattle. We got a few days of rain and some cooler temperatures to give us all that Fall feeling. I'm sure the harvest season will soon be in full swing. We wish all of you a safe and happy harvest!
