All poultry exhibits must have a negative pullorum test within ninety (90) days of entry to fairgrounds. Poultry testers will be at the pavilion at the Salem City Park on Civic Center Road to do testing on Wednesday, July 24. We ask that exhibitors whose last name starts with A-M be there between 3:00 and 5:00 p.m. and exhibitors whose last name starts with N-Z be there between 5:00 and 7:00 p.m. There will be no charge for the test.

Poultry exhibits must be enter online at www.fultoncountyfair.org by <u>July 15, 2019</u>. No paper entry forms will be accepted for poultry exhibits. Exhibitors who need help in entering online should contact their Extension Agent or the Fulton County Fair office.

Ribbon Point Value for awards: Blue -10 pts, Red -8 pts, and White -6 pts. Division 200 4-H Poultry Chain points are Blue -15 Pts., Red -10 Pts., and White -8 puts. Division 195 – Eggs, receive Blue -3 Pts., Red -2 Points, and White -1 point. No points for Grand and Reserve Champions.

All Junior and Open Poultry including 4-H poultry chain exhibits must have had a negative pullorum-typhoid test within ninety (90) days of county fair exhibition. The Fulton County Fair and Fulton County 4-H Foundation will provide this test free of charge at the City Park Pavilion on Civic Center Road on check-in day. See times above.
