Updated Post Bylaws were presented to the Post and approved at our October 8 General Membership Meeting. They have been submitted to the Legion's Department of California for their official approval. Once approved by Department, they go into immediate effect. We will now have comprehensive rules on how to deal with emergencies like the virus that suddenly closed us down last March. Every Post Legionnaire is entitled to a copy and will be furnished one upon request to me or the Post Adjutant, Brian JOHNSON. A copy is also available for review in the Post Commander's office which is open on Friday evenings. The standing Bylaws Committee constantly reviews the Bylaws for needed changes and always solicits the views of Post Legionnaires for study.

Thanks to careful emergency financial management of the Post, some innovative fund-raising ideas, and the support of so many members and friends of the Post, Post 132 continues to survive under extraordinary circumstances. Things are beginning to return to some semblance of the days before March 2020. Beyond survival, however, there remain urgent matters that also must be dealt with: replacement of the windows of our building; refinishing of our banquet room floor; installation of security systems; management of our museum; rebuilding of our financial reserve; restrooms upgrading; kitchen and bar improvements; additional Bylaws revisions; building accommodations for the disabled; and many other matters.

You can be sure your Post Executive Committee will be addressing all the issues facing us, and, if you are aware of other issues not addressed, please, please bring them to any Executive Committee member (they are all listed on the last page of each Bugle and many of us are at every Friday night Post Dinner); or bring them up at the Post General Membership Meetings on the Second Thursday of each month (if you are a Legionnaire) or through your allied organization (the Auxiliary, SONs, AL Riders, UMAVA, AVU, etc.). Our Facebook page (https://www.facebook.com/groups/AmLegionPost132) is also a convenient way to respectfully and quickly bring up matters relevant to the Post and Veterans and communicate with us.

November brings us to Veterans Day and Thanksgiving: a time to remember those who served and give thanks for, appreciate and reflect on what we have. Remember our friends and family who are not with us this year. Have a blessed and safe November and feel free to contact me anytime if I can be of any help.
