MOORE & YAMADA CLAIM FIRST GISBT CHAMPIONSHIPS

YAMADA OVERPOWERS FIELD TO CAPTURE FIRST TOUR TITLE

Kai Yamada, a powerful 2-hander from Kaneohe, Hawaii was in the finest form of his career at this month's GISBT event, and it yielded him his first-ever GISBT championship. The 19 year-old qualified in the top spot – although by just a single pin – at +201 for his 8-game block. During the match play finals, he maintained good form, trading the lead with several other finalists, but never straying far from the top spot.

235 – 214 POSITION ROUND WIN LOCKS UP VICTORY

Yamada entered the position round with a 14-pin edge over 4-time titleholder Seth Sikkema, setting up a potential showdown for the title. It appeared one of these 2 would be the champ, however next door, 3rd place Zach Greim was staging a monumental comeback by firing the front 9. This set up a 3-way battle heading into the final frame of the tournament. Sikkema finished with 204, and when Greim failed to strike on his 10th delivery, Yamada needed a 10th frame mark to secure the victory. A solid pocket strike did the trick, and his finishing 235 was enough to lock up the win, with the final margin being 46 pins, although that was much closer than it appeared.

YAMADA IS 5th CONSECUTIVE FIRST-TIME CHAMP

At last month's Tournament of Champions, Yamada qualified for his first match play finals, earning a 4th place finish. This month, he out-bowled a strong finals field, with the top 4 performers all being powerful 2-handers.

Yamada became the 5th consecutive first-time champion in the boy's division, and that ties the tour record – which has occurred 4 times previously. He also became the first-ever tour champion to hail from Hawaii. The 127 different boy's champions have hailed from 15 different states (Alaska, California, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, New York, Ohio, Rhode Island, South Dakota, Texas, Wisconsin as well as Mexico.)

He averaged 218.81 for his 16 tournament games, and hauled away a \$450 scholarship for his day's work. He also earned a permanent place on Champion's Row. Congratulations, Kai!

GREIM GRABS RUNNER-UP FINISH

As mentioned previously, Zach Greim staged a heroic charge at this month's event. The right-hander from Poway, California surged into contention with a 279 in game #14, but quickly fell back with a 168 in game #15. That put him 89 pins out of the lead before the final game, but 9 straight strikes skyrocketed him back into contention. His final game of 278 enabled him to leapfrog into the runner-up spot and claim a \$325 scholarship. This marked his 2nd straight finals appearance; last month he finished 6th at the season opener in Davenport.

BRAND NEW MAPLE LANES WELCOMES GISBT

The GISBT was returning to a brand new Maple Lanes after 2 years away. A criminal fire destroyed the bowling center in February 2020, and after 18 months, the bowling center welcomed GISBT competition back to the Waterloo area. The bowling center looked incredible! Congratulations on an awesome rebuild & thanks to Maple Lanes for welcoming the best young bowlers in the Midwest!

This was the 287th tournament in GISBT history. Maple Lanes has been one of the tour's most loyal supporters, with the tour visiting every season year since 1992; the only exception was last season while the bowling center was being constructed. The 2nd event in our tour's history was contested at Maple Lanes – 30 years ago – on September 13, 1992.

4-TIME CHAMP SIKKEMA STAKES 3rd

Seth Sikkema was in solid form this month, as the muscular right-hander from Fulton, Illinois was gunning for career title #5. Appearing in the 17th match play finals of his career, Sikkema instead finished in 3rd place; he earned a \$250 scholarship for his performance.

TACORDA IN CAREER FORM, NABS 4th

Andre Tacorda completed the quartet of powerful 2-handers at the top of this month's standings. The Roseville, California native finished in 4th place – his best tour finish – and it helped secure a \$225 payday. It marked his 3rd foray into the match play finals, with his previous best finish was a 6th place showing in the January 2020 tour stop in Muscatine.

BIANCHI 5th IN SECOND STRAIGHT FINALS

It has become obvious in recent tour stops that Jacob Bianchi has become one of the tour's most improved players. This month, the talented right-hander from Altoona, IA rolled into his 2nd straight match play finals. By the end of the day, he had earned his highest career tour finish – a 5th place showing that earned him a \$200 payday. Last month, Bianchi enjoyed a breakthrough performance by qualifying for his first ever match play finals, eventually finishing in 8th place.

DENTON EARNS 6th

Zack Denton returned to the match play finals for the 6th time in his career. The hard-throwing right-hander from Waverly, Iowa wound up in 6th place, capturing a \$175 scholarship for his efforts.

ROTH PLACES 7th

Corey Roth rolled into Waterloo hot on the heels of his first tour victory last month in Davenport, and he continued in fine form by finishing 7th. Roth was one of five 2-handers in this month's match play finals, and he walked away with a \$150 scholarship.

ERICKSON TAKES 8th

Isaac Erickson completed this month's boy's finals field. The Lititz, Pennsylvania native finished in 8th place, hauling away a \$125 scholarship for his efforts. Erickson has now qualified for 3 consecutive match play finals, and 4 in his tour career.

MOORE A TOUR CHAMP AT LAST

MOORE BREAKS THROUGH IN CAREER FINALS # 9

Rachel Moore achieved a noteworthy goal at this month's tour stop. After 8 match play appearances – including a pair of runner-up finishes – the 17 year-old from Keokuk, Iowa grabbed her first GISBT title. Moore made her GISBT debut at the tender age of 9 in Muscatine back in October 2014. Since then, she's appeared in 43 tour events. Close calls along the way only made this month's victory all the sweeter.

The right-hander was clearly the best this month, as she posted the best qualifying score (+62 for 8 games), and the best match play round pinfall (+18 for 6 games). She also logged a 4-2 match play record along the way. Moore entered the position round with a substantial 90-pin edge, and despite a 212-181 loss, it was good enough to hang on for a 29-pin margin of victory. Moore became the 88th different girl's champion since the tour began in August 1992. Her \$400 winner's share of the purse pushed her career earnings on tour past the \$2,000 mark – she's now swept in \$2,165 in tour earnings. She averaged 205.71 for her 14 games. Congratulations, Rachel!

CARR RUNNER-UP IN TOUR DEBUT

Elena Carr is a new face on the GISBT scene. The Hilton, New York native finished as the tournament runner-up in her tour debut. She won a \$300 scholarship. Carr finished as this summer's 3rd place finisher in the girl's U18 Junior Gold event in Indianapolis.

3-TIME CHAMP DUVER-BORROZ PLACES 3rd

Hanna Duver-Borroz was this month's 3rd place finisher. The 3-time tour champion was returning to the match play finals for the 34th time in her standout career. She took home a \$250 scholarship for her performance.

HAMMAN FINISHES 4th

Jaelle Hamman made her GISBT debut a successful one, as she finished 4th. The right-hander from Jarrell, Texas took home a \$200 scholarship for her work. Hamman won the biggest title of her career this summer when she emerged as the girls U18 Junior Gold champion. This meant the GISBT enjoyed seeing 2 of the top 3 finishers in the Junior Gold U18 division join our tour this month.

McCARTHY EARNS 5th

Katrina McCarthy is now 2 for 2. The lanky left-hander from Pelican Lake, Wisconsin finished 4th last month in her tour debut, and this month she returned to match play finals again, ultimately finishing in 5th place; she won a \$150 scholarship for her day's work.

EVANS COMPLETES FINALS FIELD, TAKES 6th

Gabi Evans rounded out this month's girls finals field. The talented right-hander from West Liberty, Iowa finished 6th, earning a \$125 scholarship for her performance. Evans was appearing in the 7th match play finals of her tour career.
