NEWSLETTER UPDATE ON TINY HOMES-Kalamazoo January 2020

Hello and HAPPY New Decade!

I am so excited that the Lutheran Church of the Savior remains committed and interested in the Tiny Houses of HOPE Pilot (THoHP) Project! and extremely grateful for the outpouring of financial support at and stemming from Commissioner Praedel's Mingle! To date the highest donations coming from a Mingle 4 Shingles came from Lutheran Church of the Savior!

We have been in conversations with the Home Builders Association but have not finalized any actual collaboration, but we are HOPEful that we will, if not with the Northside Tinnies then the next ones slated to go up in the Vine Neighborhood. Just for the sake of clarity, the Home Builders Association's recent project that just made the news is nothing like the THoHP Project at all. We are building 400 sq. ft, affordable housing, for a very specific demographic of marginalized people. The Home Builders Association are building small homes that are NOT necessarily considered affordable housing. They may be for low-income people, but the two are not the same. I have been following their work pretty closely and am optimistic that are work will intersect in the near future.

Since are presentation in November, there have not been any significant developments. The newest developments were shared with the folks who attended the Mingle. I am happy to keep LCS in the loop as we proceed closer to groundbreaking and beyond.
