Moving and handling easier

We have developed **Junior Smart Sheets**, which makes moving larger children a much easier task. Our range includes various sizes of tubular and flat sheets that are usually used in pairs. Our sheets have handles on and around each side, enabling handling from any position.

Smart Sheets are constructed from specially coated nylon to ensure very low friction with polypropylene webbing that provides parents and carers with the optimum slide for ease of movement and turning. The webbing handle feature and the extension straps that loop through the flat sheet handles enable horizontal transfers and help to improve the handler's posture while minimizing pressure on the shoulders, wrists and fingers when performing tasks.

They are extremely useful for positioning on all kinds of surfaces and ideal for sliding up and down the bed, swiveling into and out of the bed, repositioning and sliding

onto wedges on the floor during physiotherapy.

All of our comfy Splints, Rest Splints and Night Gaiters are designed and manufactured for pediatric and infant sizing to meet the needs of even our smallest customers. With easy adjustability, high comfort level and pediatric friendly colors, kids love our splints.

Essential to the use of orthosis are factors such as the prevention of deformity by the proper positioning of weakened segments, the control or stabilization of joints proximally to those activated or the prevention of unwanted motions. Orthoses may also be used to correct present deformities. They are both therapeutic and functional.

Splints are used for the following functions:

- Stabilize (immobilize) joints in a desired position to rest the joints, tendons, ligaments and muscles or maintain a certain bone alignment.
- Prevent contracture or deformity.
- · Prevent unwanted motion.
- Gradually stretch contracture to increase range of motion.
- Provide support for flaccid hand and wrist.
- Maintain gains achieved by manipulation, corrective surgery or reconstructive procedures.
- Relieve pain.
- Prevent pressure sores or facilitate the healing of existing pressure areas

*Should be prescribed by a professional.

Wrist Rehabilitation – hand splints gaiters



Reverse lasted correction footwear

Reverse lasted correction footwear is designed to correct feet with extreme varus and/or adduction. The special last shape achieves this correction. Inside, the shoe is equipped with a special inlay, which in combination with an extended medical stiffener forms a curved wall in conjunction with the toecup, preventing the foot from processing further into adduction.



These shoes are especially important for children who are born with clubfeet. Treatment with reverse lasted shoes will help their feet to develop normally.

Indications for use:

- ✓ Clubfoot
- ✓ Significant varus
- ✓ To correct the peak position in the upper tarsal joint
- ✓ To improve toe-off
- ✓ To correct the varus tilting in the lower tarsal joint and the future metatarsal area
- ✓ To stabilize post-operative clubfoot.

AFO sports footwear is designed and made especially for children who need to wear an AFO or an inner shoe. The biomechanical requirements of this footwear are of major importance and our last is constructed to ensure a correct position of the lower limb at an exact 90 degree angle and allows enough room for an AFO.
