

Synergy Admissions Policy

To enrol a child at Synergy School it is necessary to complete the application form and return it with the other relevant documents to the school office along with the €160 registration fee.

The deposit of €600.00 should be paid to the school office as soon as enrolment has been completed. The deposit is returnable provided the school has received a notice period of three months. The deposit can be used towards any outstanding balances.

The school fees are:

€4800.00 per annum KS3 (11-13) (Years 7, 8 & 9)

€5600.00 per annum KS4 (14-16) (Years 10 & 11)

These prices are for Synergy only – you must speak with your sports provider for the costs relating to their programmes. Transportation between sites is also not included in the fees and must be arranged privately.

Lunch Costs: €800

If your child is an English as Second Language speaker then there may be additional costs for supporting their language acquisition after completion of their first year at Synergy.

These fees should be paid during the ten days after the commencement of term directly to the school bank account – clearly stating the name of the student/s.

Late payment of fees is subject to a 5% surcharge. If your fees are going to be late please contact the School Office to make arrangements.

Additional costs may be required for the following:

- Duke of Edinburgh Awards
- IGCSE Exams
- Readers or Scribes for IGCSE if required
- Educational or Recreational trips

Admittance of children over the age of 11 is subject to entrance exams in English and Math (English as Additional Language if applicable). The school requires a full report from the previous school. The school also requires reports and certifications from the current coach or trainer along with a sports diagnostic test. A short interview with either the Head or the Head of Curriculum. A final decision will be reached once all these stages have been completed.
