## ORDINANCE NO. 52

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Rolla, North Dakota, UNLAWFUL TO SELL OR STORE EXPLOSIVE AND COMBUSTIBLE PRODUCTS WITHOUT PERMISSION OF COUNCIL.

Sec. 1. No person, persons, firm or corporation, shall erect, construct, build or remodel any building within the limits of the city of Rolla, North Dakota for the purpose of using the same for the storage or sale of gunpowder, tar, pitch, resin, coal oil, benzine, turpentine, hemp cotton, nitroglycerine, petroleum, or any of the products thereof, and other combustible or explosive material, nor shall such person, persons, firm or corporation, keep any of the above mentioned products for storage and sale, within said city limits, without first having obtained permission of the city council of the city of Rolla, N. Dak. therefore, any person, persons, firm or corporation desiring to keep any of the above mentioned products for storage or sale shall apply to the city council of the city of Rolla, N.D., in writing for permission therefore, which application shall state the kind of product or products desired to be kept, the approximate amount desired to be kept and the place where the same shall be kept for said time and sale. The city council may said application in whole or in part if same or any part of same is specify the kind and amount of to be kept and the place within the said city limits where same shall to be stored or sold.

Sec. 2. PENALTY. - Any person who shall in any manner violate and the provisions of this ordinance shall be of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, be fined not less than five nor more than fifty dollars, and each sale therefore be contrary to the terms of this ordinance shall be deemed a separate offense.
