Dear College and High School Students,

You are being invited as a guest of the St. Boniface Parish community to participate in a College Informational Forum to be held at the St. Boniface Parish Hall on Saturday, May 19, 2018 from 9:00am to 12:00pm. We ask that the attending 2018 college graduates include a short biography (see form on reverse side).

The forum will consist of college students who are communicants of St. Boniface to share their college experience with high school students (grades 10-12) from Lunenburg High School and other surrounding school and church communities. **College and High School Students: please fill out the registration form on reverse side.**

We will be serving brunch throughout the event. Father Anthony will open and close the forum with prayer. We will have a forum moderator who will introduce each speaker and maintain a time schedule for the event.

We will be asking the college students, class of 2018, to address the high school student audience with a prepared 2 - 3 minute speech about their personal college experience. The speakers will be encouraged to talk about how to help high school students prepare for college: what went right, what they learned and how they could have better prepared, what they absolutely would do before entering college, what they would absolutely encourage others to do while attending college, and how their faith interacted with their college experience. Lastly, we will have all 2018 graduates give a short presentation on how they look forward to their future careers or their next endeavor.

The second segment of the forum will consist of an open question and answer period directed at those college students who will be entering their second, third and fourth years at their perspective institutions. We ask that these college students talk about topics such as: dorm experience versus living off campus, campus life, their experience with professors, and to comment on questions that may be asked by the high school student audience.

This will be our first year attempting this forum. We look forward to making the event successful by providing insight to future college students that will be useful as they plan to enter an institution of higher learning. What will make this event unique is the personal input of those college students who have recently graduated and those who are currently experiencing college life. We hope you can join us!
