

Minutes of Meeting on Nov 23, 1990  
Vice Commander - Mike Shane Presiding  
Meeting Convened at 8<sup>35</sup> PM 32 members present

Committee Reports:

Hospital Visitation - It was reported that Past Commander Jerry Pollie was in hospital and now is at home recuperating.

House Chairman - Vining Zangari reported that the leak at the furnace had been repaired and that the repairs were covered under our service contract.

Treasurer's Report: Joe Miller reported the balance in the checking account amounted to 6,965.13. Some of these funds should be transferred to the Corporation account.

The amount to be transferred has to resolved. He reported that our ~~check~~ <sup>check</sup> of \$50 ~~was~~ <sup>was</sup> returned for the Desert Shield Support Group. This organization has no bank account in its name and therefore unable to cash the \$50 check.

Old Business - Locally Installation at Crystal Room

Motion seconded and passed.

Good of Legion - Charles Fontang stated we should try to get the American Legion National Organization to sponsor a Geacys Health Insurance program opened to members. This should help, as a group, to lower Health Insurance rates. This proposal should be started at the County level and move up to the state and then to the National Organization.

Phil Fazzetto thanked the Committee and the Post for his Life Award dinner.

Venry Zangari reported that he had \$3 in the refreshment fund and spent \$14 for tonights meeting leaving a balance of \$79<sup>00</sup>
