Cosmetology Instructor Program

Program Objective

This program is designed to prepare the student for the State Board Examination upon successful completion of 600 hours. Students will learn theory and practical training to include basic principles of student teaching, psychology, evaluation, counseling, record-keeping, state law, etc.

Upon receiving this professional license, the student will possess the skills and knowledge to be employed as an entry-level instructor.

Admission Requirements

-Proof of completion of the 10th grade, High School Diploma, or GED

-Minimum age of 16 (must be 17 years of age before completion of the program)

-Licensed as a Cosmetologist

This course takes approximately 19 weeks to complete with the hours of 8:45 AM to 5 PM Monday - Friday.
